

### Asylum Statistics Key:

<b>ABC Cases</b>	“American Baptist Churches” cases. See <a href="#">American Baptist Churches v. Thornburgh (ABC) Settlement Agreement</a> for more information.
<b>MPA</b>	Minor principal applicants. Affirmative asylum applicants under age 18 at the time of filing.
<b>Pre-Reform</b>	The term pre-reform applies to asylum applications filed prior to January 4, 1995. January 4, 1995, is the date that asylum reform regulations took effect following a Presidential mandate to streamline the affirmative asylum process.
<b>PRL</b>	Not an acronym. Asylum applicants of any age filing with USCIS under the initial jurisdiction provision of the 2008 Wilmer Wilberforce Torture Victims Protection Reauthorization Act (TVPRA) while in removal proceedings.
<b>Reform</b>	The term reform applies to asylum applications filed on or after January 4, 1995.
<b>UAC</b>	Unaccompanied Alien Child. See 6 U.S.C. § 279(g)(2).

<b>ZAR</b>	Arlington, VA Asylum Office
<b>ZCH</b>	Chicago, IL Asylum Office
