Overseas Military Naturalization

Oct. 9, 2019 8 to 8:45 a.m. Eastern 7 to 7:45 p.m. Eastern

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) invites you to participate in a teleconference to discuss new procedures for military naturalization overseas. We will hold two teleconferences to accommodate international callers. The information presented will be the same for each call, so you can join the one that is most convenient for you. The teleconferences will take place on **Oct. 9**, **from 8 to 8:45 a.m. Eastern**, **and from 7 to 7:45 p.m. Eastern**.

USCIS announced new locations for overseas military application processing. These locations were selected based on their proximity to locations where USCIS historically provided the most overseas military naturalization services. USCIS and the Department of Defense (DOD) are working to help service members and eligible family members who seek to become U.S. citizens through the naturalization process while stationed overseas.

During these engagements, USCIS staff will review the new procedures and share resources that are available to military members and their families. We will conclude with a question and answer session. We will not answer case-specific questions.
