Service Motion on Administrative Appeals Office Decision

Form I-360, Petition for Amerasian, Widow(er), or Special Immigrant (Special Immigrant Juvenile)

The Petitioner seeks classification as a special immigrant juvenile (SIJ) under sections 101(a)(27)(J) and 204(a)(1)(G) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(27)(J) and 1154(a)(1)(G). The Director of the New York, New York District Office (Director) denied the Petitioner's Form I-360, Petition for Amerasian, Widow(er), or Special Immigrant (SIJ petition), and the Petitioner appealed that decision to the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO). On January 10, 2020 we dismissed the Petitioner's Form I-290B, Notice of Appeal or Motion, because the form was not fully completed. On March 22, 2021, we rejected the Petitioner's subsequent appeal because it was untimely filed. On September 28, 2022, we dismissed the Petitioner's motion to reconsider.

Upon further review of the record, we hereby reopen the proceedings, withdraw our prior decision, and remand the matter to the Director of the National Benefits Center for reconsideration of the Applicant's eligibility for SIJ classification. 8 C.F.R. § 103.5(a)(5).

ORDER: The decision of the Administrative Appeals Office is withdrawn. The matter is remanded to the Director of the National Benefits Center for the entry of a new decision.
