Motion on Administrative Appeals Office Decision

Form I-360, Petition for Amerasian, Widow(er), or Special Immigrant (Special Immigrant Juvenile)

The Petitioner seeks classification as a special immigrant juvenile (SIJ) under sections 101(a)(27)(J) and 204(a)(1)(G) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act), 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(27)(J) and 1154(a)(1)(G). SIJ classification protects foreign-born children in this country who cannot reunify with one or both parents because of abuse, neglect, abandonment, or a similar basis under state law. The Director of the Raleigh-Durham, North Carolina, Field Office revoked approval of the Petitioner's Form I-360, Petition for Special Immigrant Juvenile, and we dismissed a subsequent appeal. The Petitioner then filed a motion to reopen our previous decision; and she also filed a subsequent motion to reopen presently before us. As we have granted the Petitioner's first motion to reopen and sustained her appeal in a separate decision, no purpose would be served in adjudicating the current motion relating to the same petition. We will therefore dismiss the instant motion to reopen as moot.

ORDER: The motion to reopen is dismissed.
