Appeal of California Service Center Decision

Form I-821, Application for Temporary Protected Status

The Applicant, a national of Haiti, seeks Temporary Protected Status (TPS) under section 244 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act), 8 U.S.C. § 1254a.

The Director of the California Service Center denied the TPS request, concluding that the Applicant did not establish eligibility for such status because he did not submit a complete Form I-821 as required by regulations. On appeal the Applicant submits a properly completed Form I-821, and explains that he inadvertently missed one question on the form he initially filed.

The record reflects that while the instant appeal was pending the Director approved the Applicant's previously filed Form I-821 with a TPS validity date through August 3, 2024. Because the Applicant has been granted the immigration benefit he requested, his appeal is no longer necessary. We will therefore dismiss the appeal as moot.

ORDER: The appeal is dismissed.
